**Subject: WITHDRAWAL OF RATIONALIZATION POLICY APPROVED IN PEC 77<sup>TH</sup> EA&QEC/EAB MEETING**

Reference to PEC Letter No. PEC/AD/Policy/DL-77(Gen.)/2016 dated August 19, 2016 regarding rationalization of Intake Policy for HEIs.

2. The subject matter was discussed under agenda item No. 1 (b) in PEC 83<sup>rd</sup> EA&QEC/EAB meeting and decision taken by the committee is as below:

*“Rationalization Policy is withdrawn immediately and all HEIs will be directed to take the students as per the previous allowed intake (i.e. intake prior to Rationalization Policy approved in PEC 77<sup>th</sup> EA&QEC/EAB meeting). The class size will remain as 40 to 50 students per section based on the available infrastructure / facilities along with the faculty and complying the allowable student teacher ratio. If any HEI desires to increase the student intake in a particular program, they will have to apply for Change of Scope (Increase in Intake) visit for the same. To apply for Change of Scope (Increase in Intake), the HEI will have to meet the student teacher ratio as 20:1 in addition to other laid down requirements. The enhanced intake of student already admitted / enrolled will be covered as one time dispensation and HEI will inform PEC about enhanced students’ data for each engineering program immediately”.*
